Port Forwarding


Steps to set up port forwarding to a Genius Hub:

- 1. Find the IP address of the Genius Hub on your network
 - a. Make a note of the UID of your Genius Hub (printed in blue text on the back of the Hub)
 - b. Log in to your broadband router
 - c. Find the section that lists 'Connected devices'
 - d. Find the entry for your Genius Hub. Entries should show a 'MAC address' the Genius Hub ID will match the last part of the MAC address

2. Set up the port forwarding

- a. Log in to your broadband router
- b. Find the area that allows you to set up port forwarding
 - i. This may also be listed as 'Port Redirection', 'Services', or similar
- c. Set the following parameters (you may need to select 'Add new entry' or similar)
 - i. Public port: 1222
 - ii. Private Port: 1222
 - iii. Protocol: TCP or Both
 - iv. Source IP: Any (not required)
 - v. Private IP: enter the IP address found in step 1

(please note that the settings page on your router will not look exactly the same as this, the example below is purely illustrative)
